But if thou wilt go, if thou wilt do it, and strengthen thyself for the battle, God shall make thee fall before the enemy …"- 2 Chronicles 25:7-8 (Jubilee Bible 2000); And also says elsewhere- "Should thou [king Jehoshaphat] help the ungodly, and love those that hate הוה '? Therefore, the wrath of the presence of הוה 'shall be upon thee"- 2 Chronicles 19:2 (Jubilee Bible 2000)

Then you will live in the land forever."- Psalm 37:27 (Common English Bible).
